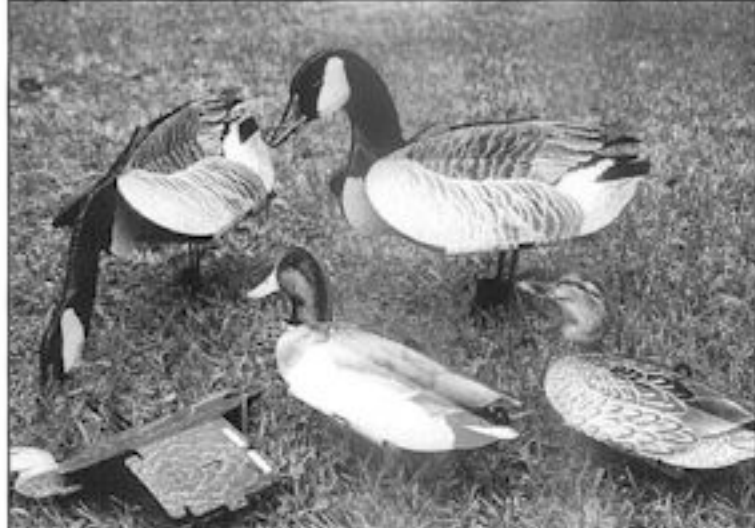
Browning *Travel Vault*

They come in both duck and goose and you will be able to use them for all you're hunting locations for they are both field and water decoys. The metal stake can be hammered into the frozen ground and also acts as a weighted keel when used in water. it made a believer out of me. We were able to call gadwalls in time and time again with this fine call. The old Duck Commander has done it again.
